CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS (2024-25)

- * All principles and provisions of the Constitution of India are strictly to be observed.
- Punctuality and regularity in class attendance is of utmost priority. 75 % attendance is mandatory. In case of shortfall in attendance, for any reason what-so-ever, the competent authority of the College can impose CONDONATION FEE or take punitive action, as may be deemed fit and proper.
- * Identity card and Library card must be compulsorily carried by each student within the campus and for attending programmes off the campus on a regular basis to prove his bonafide status.
- Students are strictly discouraged from using mobile phones in classrooms and the Library.
- * Attendance of parents in Guardian-Teacher meetings is obligatory.
- * Students should avail the support of Anti-Ragging Cell and Sexual Harassment Prevention Cell, Internal Complaints Committee or the College Grievance Redressal Portal (Please refer to the college website). Grievance redressal provisions are to be solicited and the final decision of the Principal is binding upon all.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

(2024-25)

- Students shall not damage institutional property and refrain from engaging in any activity that leads to the incurrence of financial loss by the college.
- * The students cannot join in any coercive agitation/strike for the purpose of forcing the authorities of the College to solve any problem or that may have a tendency to disturb the peace and tranquillity of campus/Hostel life of the institution.
- * Students have to furnish a written declaration that they will never indulge in, nor tolerate ragging, in any form, even in words or intentions.
- * The students are encouraged and entitled to give regular feedback on the quality of teaching, behaviour of teaching and non-teaching personnels of the college, students services and institutional infrastructure including Library services.
- * The students who begin with a difficulty due to social handicap or a shift in the medium of instruction are entitled and specially encouraged to seek special/ remedial support from their Departmental MENTORS to bridge the gap but are strictly prohibited from availing any paid educational services being offered to them without the knowledge of the College Authority.
- * A student is likely to face disciplinary action that may include expulsion if found guilty of untoward action both inside and outside the campus that adversely affects the goodwill of the college.
- * All students are expected to dress in a modest and respectable manner that is most befitting and are expected to maintain cleanliness within the campus.
