Curricular & Academic Flexibility (NEP Rollout)

NEP Implementation: Full adherence to NEP 2020 syllabus from Bankura University for UG and PG programs from academic year 2023-24.

Admission Test (BCCAT): Introduced Bankura Christian College Admission Test (BCCAT) for all applicants – a distinctive move outside state centralized admission, with 90% subject weightage + 10% general awareness.

Certificate Courses: 33 certificate courses offered for all-round development (e.g., Functional English, Python, Yoga Vidya, IKS, NGO Management).

Mandatory Functional English: Enrolment made compulsory for all 1st Semester students.

Teaching-Learning & Student Outcomes

Student-Teacher Ratio: 27.94 (2347 students : 84 teachers).

Pass Percentage: 91.23% pass percentage in university examinations (final year students).

Higher Progression: 320 outgoing students progressed to higher education or placement.

Scholarships: 1,506 students (64.17%) benefited from scholarships/freeships.

Language Lab: Actively used for enhancing English proficiency.

Research Grants: Received ■2.1 lakhs in 2023-24
